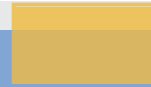

Course Components:

1. Reading Skills

Develop reading strategies to cope and understand academic English, focusing on overall comprehension, critical reading skills and understanding vocabulary from context.

2. Listening Skills

IELTS listening classes concentrate on purpose, meaning, vocabulary and structure. Students will learn a variety of techniques for comprehension.

3. Oral Skills

Students will gain the ability to speak spontaneously and convey their ideas clearly and coherently. Practice listening and responding to information orally will be a key factor in this area of preparation.

4. Writing Skills

Academic writing skills, such as developing and writing an essay that explains and supports an opinion on an issue, will be practiced.

5. Vocabulary and Reference

A fundamental part of any ability test; vocabulary development and reference skills such as using a dictionary effectively and efficiently will be practiced throughout the course.

6. Study Procedures

Successful revision and efficient time management and study skills will help the student succeed in his/her test.
